While there are doubters who say privacy is no more, Rotary clubs and districts still have a duty to be responsible with the private information entrusted to them by their members. There are a few ways to fulfill that role.

Important Message for DACdb Users: New Interface Cut Over July 1

Upgrade to the new DACdb interface now and see how easy it is to use.

Effective July 1, 2019, the DACdb classic interface will be retired. The default will be the new UI, which has been tested for over a year.

Should a user wish to continue to use the classic interface, they simply click on their name in the upper right-hand side of the screen and click on the link "Switch to Classic Interface."

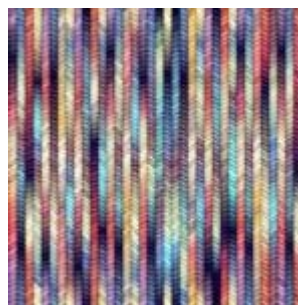
